### The Harry T. and Harriette Moore Civil Rights Museum

The Museum honors the life and contributions of Moore's who were educators that lived in and taught in segregated schools in and around Brevard County from 1925- 1946. Mr. & Mrs. Moore were the first true civil rights activist of the modern civil rights era in the state of Florida. They served as forceful advocates against racial violence and lynchings in Florida.

During this visit, we will learn about the Civil Rights climate \*over the years in the state of FL and beyond. The Museum offers memorabilia that reflects on the years since the tragic deaths, the historic reaction, and the continued impact of the legacy of the Moore's.
